

Thanks again to everyone for all of their hard work.

Several parishioners have noticed in their tithing envelopes that there are no longer envelopes designated specifically for the building fund. Last year, the Finance Council and I discussed these envelopes. The building fund envelopes were started at a time when work was being done on the Church. That work was finished, and has been payed for, but the building envelopes had continued. Money that had been given towards the building fund in recent years has gone towards upkeep of the Church. However, without any specific building project at this time, we decided we would alter our approach. Wanting to embrace a deeper philosophy of stewardship we decided to discontinue the envelopes specifically labeled building fund. Those who are accustomed to place something in that envelope, we hope will generously roll that amount into their weekly giving. Those funds are immensely helpful and we can still use them. However in the spirit of stewardship, we wanted to reduce the number of 'asks' for contributions and trust in the generosity of the weekly collection.
