

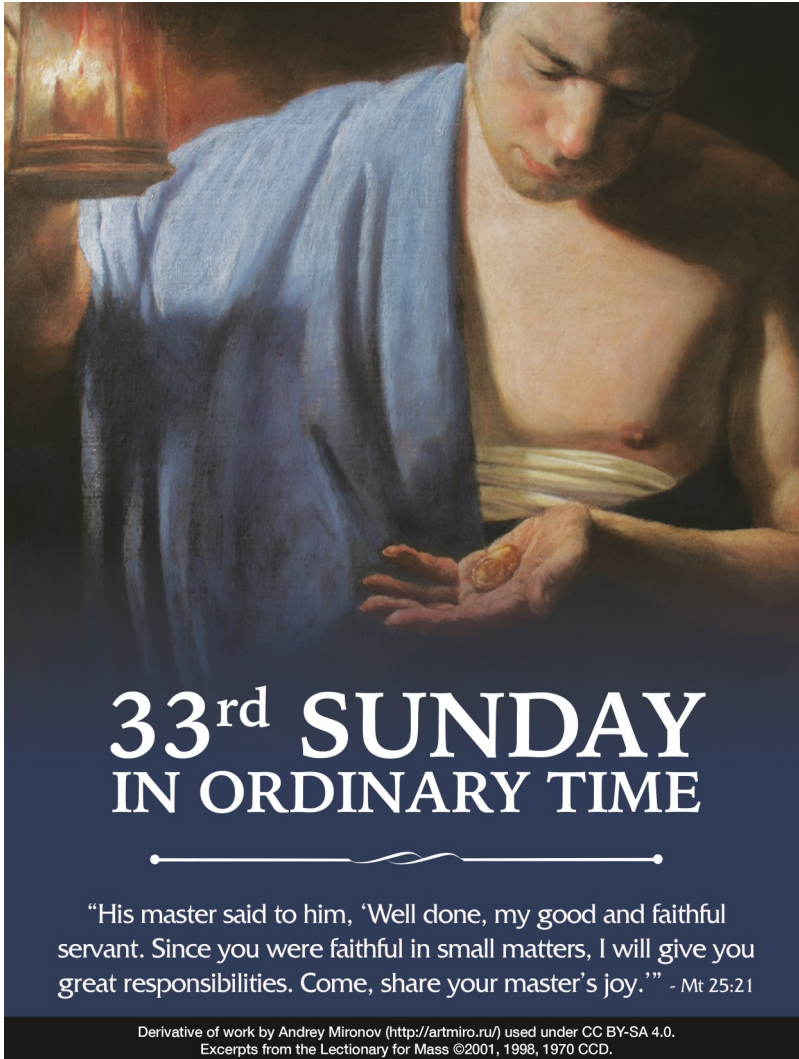

5 First Saturdays This is the 2nd First Saturday Devotion will begin

Our Lady of Fatima asked us to make the First Saturday Communion of Reparation to Her Immaculate Heart. Her promise: *"I promise to assist at the moment of death, with all the graces necessary for salvation, all those who, on the first Saturday of five consecutive months shall confess, receive Holy Communion, recite five decades of the Rosary, and keep Me company for fifteen minutes while meditating on the fifteen mysteries of the Rosary, with the intention of making reparation to Me."* Jesus revealed to Sister Lucia the meaning of the five Saturdays by making known five ways in which people offend and blaspheme against the Immaculate Heart of Mary: **1.** Against her Immaculate Conception. **2.** Against her Perpetual Virginity. **3.** Against her Divine Maternity, while refusing to accept her as the Mother of all mankind **4.** By those who try to publicly implant in the hearts of children indifference, contempt, and even hate against the Immaculate Mother. **5.** By those who insult her directly in her sacred images.

This devotion is for Saturday morning Mass, which is not the same as Saturday evening Mass, because the evening Mass counts for Sunday Mass.

“¿A QUIEN ESTAS SIGUIENDO?”

Hoy celebramos el Domingo de Compromiso—un día para re-comprometernos por completo a nuestro llamado bautismal de una vida practicando el Stewardship. ¡Que apropiado es el ser tratados como en la parábola de los talentos de este día! El Evangelio nos reta a usar TODO lo que Dios nos ha dado---tanto como sea posible--- y todo en nombre de Su Reino. Se trata de un servidor al que se le ha dado cinco talentos; el cual, uno de ellos es una cantidad desconocida de dinero. El, sabiamente lo invierte y lo multiplica al doble de lo que se le ha dado. Imagínense si aquellos a los que se les ha dado mucho, decidieran usar sus regalos con el solo propósito de edificar el Reino de Dios. Pero ¿qué pasa con el servidor al que se le ha dado solo un talento? Él tenía miedo de perderlo y mejor decidió enterrarlo. Algunos de nosotros, puede que nos sintamos que no hemos recibido mucho en forma de regalos de parte de Dios. Pero, puede que no nos hemos dado cuenta de que estos regalos están enterrados, nos estamos aferrando a ellos por miedo a perder lo poco que se nos ha dado. ¡No tengan miedo! Las lecciones de este Evangelio son claras. ¡Da de ti mismo con un corazón lleno de fe y recibirás mucho más para dar! Vive y da de tal manera, que al final de tu vida, tú también puedas oír al Padre Celestial decir: “bien hecho mi fiel y buen servidor.”
