

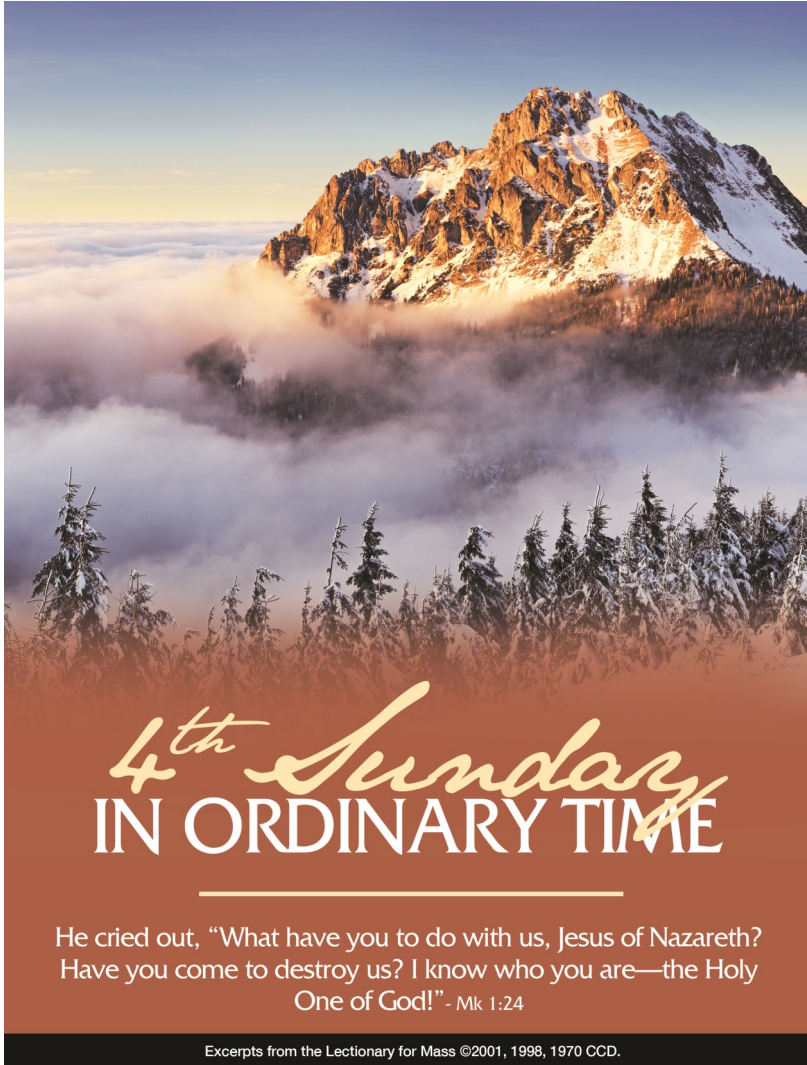

MEDITACIÓN EVANGÉLICO - ALENTAR ENTENDIMIENTO MÁS PROFUNDO DE LA ESCRITURA (Gospel Meditation)

28 de enero de 2018 4º Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario
Las personas están frecuentemente en nuestra sociedad engañando a otras por su poder al hablar, explotan y manipulan con su forma de expresión. ¿Cómo podemos discernir cuando uno que habla tiene el interés desde el corazón? La respuesta no es fácil de discernir, pero algunas indicaciones pueden ayudar para saber si el que comunica lo hace acertadamente. Que sus acciones vayan de acuerdo a sus palabras, cuando el cuidado y la compasión son evidentes y su forma de actuar es sencilla y honesta. Cuando el bienestar y punto principal de los otros es su preocupación. ¿Conoces personas que hablan con autoridad? ¿Son coherentes sus palabras y obras?
Veamos como Jesús convierte la sinagoga -un lugar de oración- en un lugar de acción, realizando el milagro de sanar al endemoniado. La autenticidad y la autoridad de Jesús fue inmediatamente discernible, no había equivocación, su actuar y hacer fue claramente entendible y respetado al mostrar la necesidad de la situación humana de la persona. El siempre actúa en beneficio del otro. Pero, ¿cuál es el reto para nosotros? ¿Cuándo hablamos con autoridad? La autoridad y el respeto muchas veces son usados para causar mal y miedo. La invitación es ser auténticos y actuar así. Estar en sintonía con los demás implica sencillamente que las palabras vayan de acuerdo con los actos que realizamos en nuestra vida diaria. En la sociedad actual, existen muchas personas poseídas por la ambición, la mentira, el orgullo, la infidelidad, el poder y mucho más. Pidamos a Jesús que diga con autoridad, "¡Cállate y sal de él!" (Mc 1, 26). Recuerda, la autoridad se adquiere con la oración y el diálogo.

Who Are You Following?

When it comes down to it, stewardship is a form of servanthood. We are called to use our gifts to serve God and to serve one another. This is what Jesus does in today's Gospel, as He establishes His public reputation. Jesus demonstrates His authority over the demon, and casts the evil spirit out of the man. Clearly, Jesus has some special gifts -- gifts that He could have used for His own glorification. Instead, He used His divine authority to free the man of the demonic possession. Jesus used His gift to heal a man, rather than using it to control him. Let us remember this as we put our own gifts to use. We are stewards of all God has given us, and we are to use those gifts in the service of the Lord!

Eso precisamente es lo que hace Jesús en el Evangelio de hoy mientras establece Su reputación pública. Jesús demuestra Su autoridad sobre el demonio y saca a los espíritus malignos fuera de aquel hombre; claramente, Jesús tiene dones especiales, dones que Él podría haber utilizado para glorificación propia. En cambio, El usó Su autoridad divina para liberar al hombre de la posesión demoniaca. Jesús usó Su don para curar al hombre, en lugar de usarlo para controlarlo. Recordemos esto mientras utilizamos nuestros propios dones. Nosotros somos practicantes del Stewardship con todo lo que Dios nos ha brindado y debemos de utilizar esos dones en servicio al Señor.
