FUN & EDUCATIONAL ACTIVITIES

Battle of the Books: Students in the 5th and 6th grade participate in battle of the books against students from other schools in the Diocese of Wichita. They are given a list of books to read throughout the school year. In April the students compete against other readers from the diocese to see who can answer the most questions about the books they read.

D.A.R.E: 5th Graders at Holy Name participate in the Drug Abuse Resistance Education Program.

Leadership Council: The Leadership Council is a student organization for the 6th Grade students.

Robotics: In the Fall of 2014 a LEGO Robotics program was started at Holy Name for the 5th and 6th grades. The program incorporates STEM education which teaches concepts that are usually taught as separate subjects in different courses and emphasizes the application of knowledge to real-life situations.
